

UPCOMING SONG TRAINING SESSIONS

Whether you plan to show your timbrados or not, song training will produce better, more valuable singers! Training sets them up to succeed as show birds, breeders, or pets because it makes them more comfortable around people and more confident singers... A fellow breeder friend of mine said it this way: "We all train our birds; some of us train them to succeed as the best, most confident singers they can be, others of us train them to fail as shy singers with incomplete songs." How do we set them up to succeed?

When I have extra song trained birds at the end of the season, they sell themselves. Those who want to adopt one sit at my dining room table as I stage them at the other end of the table in groups or individually and they audition for the potential new owner. All sing within a minute and it makes it a great experience for the buyer and for me because I can give them the bird with the song that is the best match for them.

As far as competition goes, an untrained bird will be shy and won't sing or won't sing his full song for the judge and the breeder wastes a golden opportunity to get a judge's opinion on his efforts...

**Training Your Spanish Timbrado for a Show

Have you been looking at the book *El Gran Tenor* or at our website at <http://www.spanishtimbrado.us> and been totally overwhelmed with training your birds for a show? I know I have and I thought this might be a useful training session that others could use on preparing your birds for a show.

One of the many nice things about offering your home to the Judges while they are in town is that you get to talk “birds” with them! A couple of years ago I mentioned I was leaving some of the bird’s home from the show because they would not sing for me. He asked if I minded him training them as well as me. I said surely not! Those birds did not go to that show with me, but I was able to take them to another show later in the season. What I learned is this.....I can be *told* something, but sometimes being *shown* the same thing I was told makes all of the difference. I want to share with you what I was shown during that time. I believe it will make a huge difference in how well your birds will perform during a show.
